Abu Hurayrah (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated: The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: "There has come to you Ramadaan, a blessed month which Allah has enjoined you to fast, during which the gates of heaven are opened and the gates of Hell are closed, and the rebellious devils are chained up. In it there is a night which is better than a thousand months, and whoever is deprived of its goodness is indeed deprived."

Narrated by al-Nasaa'i, 2106; Ahmad, 8769.

Abu Hurayrah (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated: The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: "Whoever fasts Ramadaan out of faith and in the hope of reward, his previous sins will be forgiven."

Al-Bukhaari, 2014; Muslim, 760

Abu Dharr (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated: The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: "Whoever prays qiyaam with the imam until he finishes, it will be recorded for him that he spent the whole night in prayer."

Abu Dawood (1370)

Aa'ishah (may Allah be pleased with her) narrated: The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) used to spend the last ten days of Ramadaan in i'tikaaf until he passed away, then his wives observed i'tikaaf after him."

Zayd ibn Khaalid al-Juhani (may Allah be pleased with him) narrated: The Messenger of Allah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: "Whoever gives iftaar to one who is fasting will have a reward like his, without that detracting from the fasting person's reward in the slightest."

Narrated by al-Tirmidhi, 807; Ibn Maajah, 1746

Narrated by Anas who said: "Allah's Apostle (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) used to break the fast with fresh dates before praying, and if not fresh dates then with older dates, and if not with dates then with some mouthfuls of water."

Narrated by Abdullah ibn 'Amr ibn al-'Aas who said Allah's messenger (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) said: "Indeed there is for the fasting person, when he breaks his fast, a supplication which is not rejected."
